- ♦ **Adult English as a Second Language**-classes are held for beginner and intermediate adult students at the College of Southern Maryland. To enroll, students must schedule an orientation appointment.
- ♦ **Maryland Adult National External Diploma Program** is a nationally recognized high school diploma program for adults, 18 and older. It is an alternative to the GED exam and is designed for adults who have developed high school level skills through life experiences.

- ♦ **Citizenship Preparation**-learn more about civic rights and responsibilities that come with citizenship. Work on skills and knowledge needed to be successful in the citizenship process.
