EQUIPMENT NEEDS



Charles County Government, Department of Community Services, Aging and Human Services Division maintains a medical equipment loan closet to facilitate temporary provision of durable medical equipment to persons who are 60 years of age and older. Supplies are limited to what is on hand at the time of the request, but generally consist of: walkers, canes, bath/shower benches, and transport wheelchairs. Equipment on-hand in the loan closet can be checked out, free of charge, for a period of 90 days. **Based on eligibility.
